Romans 5:12-14 - 12 Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way, death came to all people, because all sinned—13 To be sure, sin was in the world before the law was given, but sin is not charged against anyone's account where there is no law. 14 Nevertheless, death reigned from the time of Adam to the time of Moses, even over those who did not sin by breaking a command, as did Adam, who is a pattern of the one to come.

Meditation:

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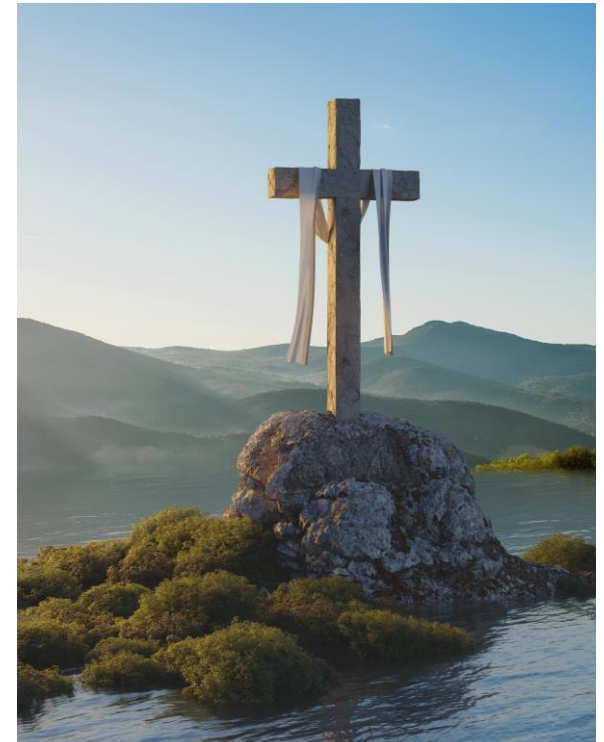

25/3/2024 – Monday

1 Peter 2:24 - He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness.

By his wounds you have been healed.

Meditation:

What is the main reason for Jesus to die on the cross?

Prayer:

Pray for Lord Jesus' forgiveness of our sinful thoughts and actions that displease the Lord so we can be set free from bondage of sins and fear.

26/3/2024 - Tuesday

Matthew 26:28 - This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.

Meditation:

Why did Jesus shed His own blood to make a covenant with us?

Prayer:

Jesus' covenant is a sure and true promise to us.

His precious blood to cleanse us spiritually and naturally for a breakthrough in life that pleases the Lord.

27/3/2024 - Wednesday

Isaiah 53:4-5 - 4 Surely, he took up our pain and bore our suffering, yet we considered him punished by God, stricken by him, and afflicted. 5 But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed.

Meditation:

How can we feel peace despite the crucifixion of Jesus? Are we healed by Lord Jesus' whipped wounds?

Prayer:

True peace is proclaiming the Lord Jesus is Almighty God, not worldly temporal peace and this is to every child who desires and seeks Him. Healing of illness and injuries takes place restoring good health in body, soul, and spirit.

28/3/2024 - Thursday

Hebrews 2:9 - 9 But we do see Jesus, who was made lower than the angels for a little while, now crowned with glory and honour because he suffered death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone.

Meditation:

Why did Jesus born and live as human before died on the cross?

Prayer:

The hope of eternal life is accepting Lord Jesus as personal Saviour. The Lord loves the world to understand human suffering and death not bound by sin.

The Lord ultimately wants us to receive the uncorrupted eternal crown of honour and glory together.

29/3/2024 - Friday

2 Corinthians 4:7-12 - 7 But we have this treasure in jars of clay to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us. 8 We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair; 9 persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed. 10 We always carry around in our body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be revealed in our body. 11 For we who are alive are always being given over to death for Jesus' sake, so that his life may also be revealed in our mortal body. 12 So then, death is at work in us, but life is at work in you.

Meditation:

Why do people experience suffering and sorrow in life?

Prayer:

We are often inspired by the Word of the Lord in adversities, setbacks, pain, mercy and love so we can be more than conquerors.

All our experiences in life are glorious witnesses to His power and miracles.
